As we look ahead to the new millennium, advances in technology provide Delta Sigma Pi great challenges - and great opportunities. With the addition of a new web site (February '97) and continuous updates, we are making tremendous progress in meeting those challenges.

At the recently concluded 41st Grand Chapter Congress, the Fraternity added three new areas to our web site:

- 1) Discussion Forums: This public discussion forum is available to anyone to post messages and respond to various topics such as:
 - A. Alumni Issues
 - B. Collegiate Chapters (strictly related to collegiate chapters)
 - C. Chapter Operations (all chapter operations of collegiate and alumni)
 - D. Grand Chapter Congress
 - E. Officer Training Schools (OTiS)/Regional Conferences

- 2) Downloadable graphics page: Need to create letterhead, a web site or document with a Delta Sigma Pi logo? Then download color and black and white logos in EPS, GIF or JPG formats!
- 3) Change of Address Form: Delta Sigma Pi wants to stay in touch with you! If you have moved, changed employment, married, a combination of the above or just lost touch with us, take this opportunity to update our database records with your current address, employment information or any other information for our files - or for publishing in *The DELTASIG!*

To commemorate our 90th year of Brotherhood, coming to a browser near you, will be our new chapter area. This will be a place for chapter members to view and print current publications, including manuals, officer packets and forms. Dynamic forms can be filled out and sent online to the Central Office or printed to give to any officer or member.

Each chapter will have their own customized area (password secured) that lists messages posted from the Central Office. These will include information about current accounting balances, current CEI Index Point Totals, and any other message relating to a specific chapter. General articles and dates will also be posted to become a central information center for chapter operations and all Central Office communication. This will allow all chapter members, not just officers, to access information that affects a chapter's operations.

Delta Sigma Pi is currently reviewing costs, benefits, security issues and overall value of these possible web site projects:

- * Add password protection to the discussion forums
- * Employment Opportunities - job postings (with password protection)
- * Web page that would only list chapters with web sites separated by collegiate chapters, alumni chapters and colonies.
- * Add more downloadable color graphics
- * Adding Fraternity songs (lyrics and sound)
- * Executive Committee/Board of Directors/Foundation Board/etc. Areas (password secured) - ability to post messages within these secured groups.
- * Listserves created for the Executive Committee, Board of Directors and Chapter Officer Groups
- * A searchable member database (password protected)
- * Deltasig of the Week/Tip of the Week
- * Meet the staff/Board/Executive Committee/etc.
- * Pictures and descriptions from our archives and current activities
- * Central Office Tour and information about the headquarters facility and archives
- * Corporate Sponsorship - basics, logos, links
- * Offer chapters web site hosting (on a fee basis) to maintain their own web site - collegiate chapters, alumni chapters and colonies
- * Surveys of the membership on important issues
- * Add colonies to chapter directory map

Biennial Leaders

The Final Business Session of each Grand Chapter Congress is devoted to the election of the Board of Directors who will lead Delta Sigma Pi for the subsequent biennium. At the 41st Grand Chapter Congress in New Orleans, a Grand President was elected, the Vice President for Alumni Benefits and Services was re-elected, two Provincial Vice Presidents were re-elected and two new Provincial Vice Presidents were chosen.

In addition, by Fraternity law, the Past Grand President and the 1996 and 1997 Collegians of the Year assumed positions on the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors. Executive Committee members are indicated with an asterisk below.

NORM KROMBERG* **GRAND PRESIDENT**

Norm is Director of Technology Auditing at First Data Corporation, a world leader in the processing of electronic transactions. He lives in Omaha with his wife Kimberly. A November 1981 initiate of Alpha Delta, Nebraska-Lincoln, Norm served the chapter as President, Vice President Professional Activities and Vice President Chapter Operations.

Prior to his election as Grand President, Norm served as Mid-American Provincial Vice President, 1993-97; North Central Regional Director, 1989-91; District Director, 1991-93 and on a number of national committees.

General Position Description

A Chapter Consultant is primarily responsible for counseling collegiate chapters. Besides actual counseling sessions with chapters, chapter officers and campus administrators, responsibilities include chapter research, travel logistics, and pre and post visit communications. Chapter Consultants are responsible for developing resource materials which exemplify effective chapter operations. Office responsibilities include reviewing chapter by-laws, repairing Fraternity regalia, answering inquiries, and assisting other Central Office personnel. 

Circle members are asked to support the Foundation with a minimum gift of \$10 annually while in college and at least \$50 annually as an active alumni serving the Fraternity. 
