Keynote Speaker: Michael Crome
Senior Vice President – Chief Financial Officer

Michael Crome, in his fourth season as Senior Vice President, Chief Financial Officer for the Las Vegas Raiders, possesses over two decades of leadership experience in finance, operations, technology and analytics.

Prior to joining the Silver & Black, Crome was a partner at private equity firm, Sorelle Capital and was Vice President of Finance, Planning and Analysis at Pinnacle Entertainment, and Vice President, Finance at Caesars Entertainment. He started his career as a consultant for Accenture specializing in business strategy working in various industries including automotive, government, telecommunications, and retail/e-commerce.

The Columbus, Ohio native received a bachelor's in accounting from the University of Akron and an MBA from the Darden School of Business at the University of Virginia. As a graduate student, he spent a semester in Hyderabad, India studying the dynamics of doing business in the world's fifth largest economy and most densely populated country.

Michael Crome serves as an independent director on the board of Goodwrx, Inc. He also serves on the board for Communities in Schools of Nevada, the Vegas Chamber of Commerce, and the Board of Trustees for the University of Akron Foundation. He was appointed by the Governor to serve on the Nevada Economic Forum and served as Chairman of the Board for Junior Achievement of Southern Nevada. Crome and his wife, Chaka, have one daughter, Brie. An avid distance runner, Crome completed the World Marathon Challenge, finishing seven full marathons on all seven continents over seven days.
