Delta Sigma Pi:

The University of Tennessee School of Commerce was first organized in 1916. In that year and during the following four years very little progress was made, due to the disorganization and the conservative policy that necessarily came after the outbreak of the World War. During this period the Commercial department was conducted in close co-ordination with the College of Liberal Arts, and in fact the Commercial subjects offered were nothing more than general economic courses, and these were open only to juniors and seniors.

In 1921 the School of Commerce underwent a complete reorganization, new courses were added and additional instructors were brought into the faculty. Since this change was made the school has functioned under the supervision of it's own dean and with separate registrations from the other departments of the university.

Each year has seen a marked increase in the number enrolled over the records of the previous years. In 1920 we had 45 students registered in the School of Commerce, this enrollment was increased to 103 in 1922, and again in 1923 all previous records were broken when the enrollment swelled to 177 students.

At the present time we are proud of the fact that we have 247 students working toward the degree of Bachelor of Science in Commerce. The present enrollment is composed of 19 seniors, who will be graduated in June, 24 juniors, 56 sophomores, 110 freshmen and 28 students pursuing special courses. Ten additional registrations were recorded at the beginning of the spring term.

The faculty of the School of Commerce is composed of the head of the school and five other able and efficient instructors.

For graduation a student is required to have completed 132 term-hours work, including two years of military science, physical training, and hygiene.

Four separate curricula are offered, giving the students specific training in Factory Management, Accounting, Finance, and Marketing. These courses are arranged so as to prepare those students who are planning a career in salesmanship, accounting, banking, insurance, advertising, manufacturing and other lines of business.

Each year sees the necessity of expanding the curricula to keep pace with the rapid developments in the field of business, and as a result new subjects are being added each year. In the near future a course is to be open to students wishing to prepare themselves for work in the fields of Transportation, also a more thorough course is to be given in Advertising work and management.

We, the undersigned members of the Deltasig Club of the University of Tennessee, respectfully petition for a charter in the International Fraternity of Delta Sigma Pi.

In so doing, we hereby agree to abide by the constitution, rules, and regulations of Delta Sigma Pi and to perpetuate its existence at the University of Tennessee. We faithfully believe that the members of the Deltasig Club are the type of men who will uphold and further the ideas of Delta Sigma Pi.
