Active and Faculty Members
of Delta Kappa Psi

Kent State University has undergone several important changes since it was established a quarter of a century ago as an institution for the training of teachers.

The legislative beginning of the University was in an act passed by the General Assembly in May, 1910. The legislature authorized the establishment of two more normal schools, one of them to be situated in northeastern Ohio, and directed the Governor of the State to appoint a commission to select sites for the schools. In December of that year Kent was chosen as the site of one of them. In the next year, 1911, appropriations were made by the Legislature for the erection of the first two buildings; Governor Harmon appointed the first Board of Trustees; and the latter elected the first President, Dr. J. E. McGilvrey.

In 1912 extension work was established in twenty-five centers in northeastern Ohio, and in 1913 the classroom work on the campus began with a short spring term. The fall quarter registration that year was 291. The summer quarter early attracted large numbers of students, but enrollment through the regular college year grew more slowly and in the fall of 1927 was but 600. Since that date growth has been both steady and rapid, as shown by the following autumn registrations of regular day-time students:

While the normal school offered two-year courses from the date of its opening, provision was made almost immediately for offering four-year college courses as well. The entrance requirements and graduation requirements were comparable with those of other reputable colleges. The first Board of Trustees named the school Kent State Normal in honor of W. S. Kent who donated the site to the state for this purpose. In 1915, the Board of Trustees renamed the school as Kent State Normal College at the time four-year courses were established leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Science in Education. By an act of the General Assembly in 1929, the statutory name of the school was changed to Kent State College. The same act, besides specifically authorizing the college to grant the degree of Bachelor of Science in Education, also authorized the establishment of courses leading to the degrees of Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Science, and thus laid the foundation for a College of Liberal Arts co-ordinate with the College of Education.

The ninety-first General Assembly enacted a law, which Governor Martin L. Davey signed in May, 1935, changing the name of Kent State College to Kent State University. Another measure which became a law at the same time authorized the establishment of a College of Business Administration, and

further authorized the University to offer graduate courses of instruction and to grant the Master of Arts degree.

Under the guidance and leadership of Dean Arden L. Allyn, the College of Business Administration has grown from a few students in the fall of 1936 to about 500 students in 1941.

When first organized, the college consisted of only one department and two faculty members; but less than a year after its organization, another department was added and four new faculty members were employed. Since then the college has grown to four departments, namely: the Department of Marketing, the Department of Finance, the Department of Commerce, and the Department of Secretarial Science.

The aims and scope of the college are stated in the catalog as follows:

Current trends in the economic world generally, and in northern Ohio particularly, have led to the organization of a college of Business Administration as part of Kent State University. Business has undergone a number of changes of far-reaching significance. Among these might be mentioned the growing complexity of business, the greater necessity for understanding the factors which underlie business success and failure and the greater emphasis upon the use of scientific methods for the determination of business policies. In the last analysis this means that there is now a growing need for trained men and women to direct modern business enterprises. Business is becoming in fact a profession which requires professional training.

The basic principles of any professional curriculum have been applied in the determination of the objectives of the College of Business Administration. The first objective is that of building a foundation in a liberal education, including courses in English,

science, social science, mathematics, fine arts, health education, and philosophy. Such courses as these are required of all students enrolled in the college, largely, but not entirely, during the first two years. A second broad objective is that of giving the student a background of general business information during the course of which he may come to realize his interest in the more specialized field for which he is fitted and in which he may be interested. The third major objective is thorough training in some particular field or fields of specialization which the student may choose.

Throughout this period of study, the training of the student is not in how to do a particular job or how to act in a particular situation or how to manage a particular business. Rather he will be trained so that he may fit into positions of responsibility, learning how to analyze business problems, how to discover important business information, and how to understand the broader significance of his findings. Throughout the course, emphasis is placed upon the importance of observing new factors as they develop. Frequent contacts with existing business institutions and enterprises are made so that the student may study current business practices along with sound business principles.

The Business Administration College graduated its first student in 1937, when Raymond Moran, now an instructor in the college and a faculty member of Delta Kappa Psi, was graduated. The record of graduating students since has been:

The University has also been selected by the Business Information Service of the United States Bureau of Foreign and Domestic Commerce as a depository for its publications. The purpose of this service is to provide statistics concerning industries and trends for use in the formulation of

business policy. These publications are placed in the University Library and are available to both business men and students or faculty.

Ten curricula are now offered in the college, and students may choose from any one of the following fields: Accounting, Factory Management, Finance, General Business, Industrial Testing, Management of Agricultural Cooperatives, Marketing, Newspaper Management, Personnel Administration, and Secretarial Science. Two more curricula are being offered next year. They are Business Administration of Applied Science, and Retail Merchandising.

For entrance to the College of Business Administration as a candidate for a degree, the student must be a graduate of a first grade high school with 15 units of credit. Candidates for admission into any curriculum are strongly urged to complete a minimum of 1 unit (preferably $1\frac{1}{2}$ units) of high school algebra. Students who have not completed this minimum of algebra will find themselves severely handicapped in the continuation of required courses in university mathematics, and will usually find it necessary to make up this deficiency outside of college classes by taking a non-credit course in algebra for one semester.

For either degree offered, Bachelor of Science in Business Administration or Bachelor of Secretarial Science, a minimum of 126 semester hours, including 2 hours required in recreational activities (physical education) is required, of which not less than 32 semester hours must be completed

in residence. The residence requirement may be fulfilled by attendance at the University for two semesters, or for one semester and three summer terms. The last 36 weeks must be completed in residence.

In addition, a candidate for graduation must have completed a major and minor sequence, and must have maintained a high standard of quality in his work. A quality-point-average of at least 2.0 in all subjects, and of 2.25 in each major and minor, is required.

A Professional Business Fraternity at Kent State University was first thought of early in 1974 and, in the fall of the same year, the members then considered the idea of changing that organization into such an honorary fraternity. However after weighing the pros and cons of such a move, it was decided to postpone the action until the following year.

HISTORY OF

In the meantime, one of the alumni of the College of Business Administration, Delta Kappa Psi Fraternity, Kent State would support such a fraternity, encouraging interested students to seek the aid of Miss Katherine Lamb, assistant professor of accounting, who contacted the national headquarters of one of the leading national Professional Business Fraternities, and acquired the organizational materials of those organizations.

Since these materials were restricted in their nature, Miss Lamb turned the material over to H. R. Kesting, assistant professor of business administration, since the group had invited to become a regular advisor and faculty advisor. Under his guidance, a constitution was formed and on May 31, 1975, an organization of students was formed.

The objects of the organization were:

1. To further the educational welfare of the members.

2. To foster activities designed in the fields of business.

A Professional Business Fraternity at Kent State University was first thought of early in 1937; and, in the fall of the same year, the Commerce Club considered the idea of changing that organization into such an honorary fraternity. However, after weighing the pros and cons of such a move, it was decided to postpone any action until the following year.

In the meantime, Dean Arden L. Allyn of the College of Business Administration expressed the opinion that Kent State could support such a fraternity, encouraging interested students to seek the aid of Miss Marguerite Lamar, assistant professor of accounting, who contacted the national headquarters of one of the leading National Professional Business Fraternities, and assembled the organizational materials of these organizations.

Since these fraternities were restricted to male members, Miss Lamar turned the material over to H. R. Nissley, assistant professor of Business Administration, whom the group had invited to become a regular member and faculty adviser. Under his guidance, a constitution was formed and on May 31, 1938 an election of officers was held.

The objects of the organization were:

1. To further the individual welfare of its members.
2. To foster scientific research in the fields of commerce.

3. To educate the public to appreciate and demand higher ideals in the field of business.
4. To promote, in institutions of collegiate rank, courses leading to degrees in business.

Nine persons had sufficient faith in the possibilities of the organization to return to Kent State University in the fall of 1938, attend the first meeting and pay their initiation dues. Eight of these met the requirements of the fraternity and were given the second and third degrees by H. R. Nissley and C. A. Slocum on November 28, 1938 after the fraternity had secured the official recognition of the Faculty Committee on Fraternities and Sororities and of the Student council.

Those initiated were: Norbert Fuchik, Marion Shank, Richard Cramer, Kenneth Adolph, James Lees, Harold Levinson, Pat Patterson, and Donald Scullion.

Early in the year, H. G. Wright, Grand Secretary-Treasurer of Delta Sigma Pi, spoke to the fraternity on

"The Opportunities Ahead for the College of Business Administration Graduate." Among the guests were Dr. K. C. Leebrick, president of the university, Arden L. Allyn, acting dean of the College of Business Administration; Dr. C. C. Kochenderfer, Dr. H. D. Wolfe, and C. A. Slocum.

The fraternity also heard C. L. Carlton, head of the Central United States Bank, and visited the experimental laboratories and factory of General Electric's Nela Park Plant in Cleveland.

During the school year, 1939-1940, the fraternity sponsored a series of programs at which businessmen spoke to the junior and senior students of the College of Business Administration and advised them what employers wanted them to prepare for in college. Dean Allyn was in charge of the arrangements.

Frank Fageol, president of the Twin Coach Company, also spoke to the fraternity on "How to Get a Job and Hold It."

Charles McDermott, editor of the Department Store Economist, spoke later in the year on "The Consumer Movement." F. W. Strufe, manager of the Davey Tree Company, also was heard on "Personnel Management."

Field trips were taken to Thompson Products Company, Cleveland, and Addressograph Multigraph, also in Cleveland. The Quaker Oats Company, and the Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company, both in Akron, were visited later in the year.

The highlight of this year's activity was a survey, conducted by Delta Kappa Psi among personnel directors of industries and businesses near Kent. Under the direction of the professional activities committee, which consisted of Joe Blair, Wilfred Terrill, and C. A. Slocum, the 22 actives and pledges of the fraternity covered companies within a radius of 50 miles of the university. Among the cities touched were Cleveland, Akron, Canton and Youngstown.

The fraternity also heard J. W. Vander Laan, foreign trade expert and director of the Cleveland Office of the

United States Department of Foreign and Domestic Commerce,
who spoke on "Current Problems of Trade and Commerce."






