HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

HISTORY OF EAST TEXAS STATE COLLEGE

East Texas State College grew out of the work of William L. Mayo, a pioneer in teacher education in Texas. On September 2, 1889 Mayo first opened Mayo College in Cooper, Texas. After a fire destroyed his buildings in 1894, Mayo accepted an offer of \$10,000 and 10 acres of land in Commerce, Texas. The first building was completed the next year.

After surviving two more fires in 1907 and 1911, Mayo decided to offer the property to the state. The Thirty-fifth Legislature accepted the offer on March 14, 1917; just five minutes before Mayo's own death. There were 1,598 students enrolled in 1916, with 864 teaching certificates being earned. Thousands of students had graduated from Mayo's institution of higher learning.

The scholastic year of 1917-18 found the new college located on a 50 acre plot. Dr. R. B. Binnion became its president, with a faculty of thirty teachers. In 1923 the name was changed from East Texas State Normal School to East Texas State Teachers College. It so remained until 1957, when it became East Texas State College.

In 1924 Sam H. Whitley took over the presidential duties. After his death in 1946, Dean A. C. Ferguson served as acting president until the following year. The current president, Dr. James G. Gee, became the head of the college in September, 1947.

At the present time the college is accredited by the Association of Texas Colleges, the American Association of Colleges for Teacher Education, the Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools for the Southern States, and the American Association of University Women.

The college now occupies 1,052 acres of land, with a 140 acre campus proper. There are fifteen major buildings, plus thirteen dormitories, a cafeteria, a stadium, and farm buildings on the college farm and ranch.

The faculty is exceptionally well qualified. Slightly over fifty per cent hold the earned doctorate; the absolute proportion being 79 with a doctorate and 78 possessing a master's degree or better. The curricular range is extensive also for this type of college.

Present enrollment reaches 2,808 students (1959-60). This is a record high for the long session, but the enrollment has averaged well over 2,000 for the past twelve years. The range has been from 1,772 (fall-1953-54) to 2,600 (in 1958-59) for the period 1947-59 (in the fall semester). The spring term range runs from 1,816 (1953-54) to 2,594 (1949-50). The peak load in summer was reached in 1949-50, with 2,826 registrations (for an all-time high mark).

During the past academic year 513 students received a bachelor's degree. At the same time 279 earned one of several master's degrees offered. Since 1918 the following total number

of degrees have been conferred: (1) B.S. - 9,970. (2) B.A. - 2,257. (3) B.B.A. (since 1946) - 369. (4) B.M. (since 1950) - 4. (5) B.M.Ed. (since 1944) - 90. (6) M.B.A. (since 1951) - 17. (7) M.S. (since 1938) - 1,719. (8) M.Ed. (since 1950) - 1,880. (9) M.A. (since 1938) - 795. (10) B.S. in L.S. (since 1950) - 28. (11) M.S. in L.S. (since 1952) - 58. The grand total (1917-58) equals 17,187 degrees. In the master's degrees awarded in recent years, East Texas State ranked second only to the state university itself (state colleges and universities included only).

In teacher education East Texas State College ranked second in both the number of teachers and school administrators in active service (1950-56) in Texas public school systems. Recent emphasis on cultural education and vocational preparation makes the result an all-around regional college which threatens to soon overshadow the college's fine record in teacher education.

In addition to a campus night and Saturday class program, the college maintains an extension service which reaches out over a hundred miles in every direction. On the campus there has been created an efficient guidance service; one phase of which is a placement bureau. Each year the number of students placed in both educational and industrial positions continues to accelerate upward in number.

The college is a member of the Lone Star Conference, with

varsity athletics teams in football, basketball, track, tennis, and golf representing the college. Numerous departmental, musical, religious, professional, and social clubs provide a varied program of student activities.

National service, professional, and honorary organizations are represented by Alpha Chi, Pi Omega Pi, Alpha Pi Omega, Alpha Psi Omega, Phi Delta Kappa, Kappa Delta Pi, Alpha Lambda Delta, Phi Alpha Theta, and Sigma Tau Delta. Scholarship is stressed in many ways, and a limited number of individual scholarships have been awarded annually.

The college is expanding in every way. The future looks bright for a sound educational program at East Texas State College.

HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

HISTORY OF THE BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT

In 1919, two years after the formerly private school known as East Texas Normal was taken over by the State of Texas, a Department of Business Training was set up that offered courses in bookkeeping, penmanship, and commercial arithmetic. Prior to this time a course in commercial arithmetic had been offered in the Department of Mathematics, and courses in principles of economics were taught in the Social Science Department.

In 1921 the name of the department was changed to Business Administration, and additional courses were offered in shorthand, typewriting, and business law. In 1924 a teaching methods course was added, so that a person desiring to major in business could qualify for a certificate to teach business courses in the State's secondary schools. In 1931 additional faculty were added to the Department--and again in 1933. By 1937 there were four full-time teachers in the Department and courses in accounting, marketing, and business writing were added.

In 1945 one-year programs of terminal education were added in accounting and office practice for non-degree students desiring business training beyond that available in high school. This program has been received enthusiastically by an annual average of about eighty students.

In 1947 the staff was increased and course offerings expanded sufficiently so that the BBA degree was offered in these three areas: accounting, secretarial administration, and general business.

During 1951 the Master of Business Administration degree was authorized. In 1953 the Master of Education degree was added for business majors. This makes four graduate degrees (the MA and MS were already authorized).

In 1956, the Department of Economics, which had offered a variety of economics and finance courses, was combined with the Department of Business Administration to constitute a single department for instructional and administrative purposes. Thus, students who follow one of the several professional programs for the BBA degree now complete a major and a required minor in the Department of Business Administration.

In 1958 additional areas of specialization for the BBA degree were added for finance, marketing and management. In the latter area provision is made for a certain degree of specialization in either personnel or industrial management. From 1947 through the 1958-59 session a total of 414 BBA degrees have been conferred.




At the present time a full-time staff of nine members, plus additional part-time lecturers drawn from the business community in such areas as insurance and business law offer a total of 63 courses in business administration, finance, and economics. Five of the staff members hold the doctorate, while three others are working to complete their doctor's degree at the present time.

Enrollment in the Department of Business Administration has increased steadily over the years until now approximately one-fifth of the student body of over 2800 students are majoring in


this department. In the fall semester, 1959-60, 506 students of all classifications indicated business majors. Of this total 352 were men students, and 154 were women students. By classes it totaled: Freshmen - 167; Sophomore - 110; Junior - 83; Senior - 112; Graduate - 33; and 1 special student. A grand total of 1,221 registrations for business classes, for the fall semester 1959-60, shows the expanding size of our department.

Our new two-story business building was completed last August. This building contains eleven classrooms, seventeen offices, and one conference room. (The floor plan is given on the following page.)

Scale: 1/16 inch = 1 foot






Business Administration Faculty

September 29	Letter received from J. D. Thomson, Executive Director of Delta Sigma Pi, advising that Brother Charles Farrar would visit our campus on Monday, October 19.
October 12	Reply to above letter indicating administrative approval for a men's professional business club had been granted. A faculty committee of Joe Ashby, Perry Broom, and Graham Johnson was appointed to organize it. Permission was also secured from the Committee on New Organizations on the College Campus.
October 16	The entire Business Administration departmental faculty met to discuss the club and arrangements for the impending visit of Brother Farrar.
October 19	Visit of Brother Farrar proved most enlightening and pleasant. Valuable information was secured.
November 2	Sixty-three students and faculty members attended the organizational meeting of the club. The following officers were elected: President - Kenneth Dacus. Senior-Vice-President - Don Weaver. Vice-President - Jack Norman. Secretary - Bernard Godley. Treasurer - Mason Backus. Historian - Otis Moreland. Reporter - Don Winkle. Adviser - P.M. Broom (assisted by Graham Johnson, Joe Ashby, and Ray Stapleton). The name of the club was approved by formal vote (unanimously). The time of regular meeting was set for 8 p.m., the second Thursday of each month. A committee to draw up a local constitution and by-laws was appointed--with Otis Moreland as chairman. Local dues were set at \$2 a semester.

Work on the petition to Delta Sigma Pi was authorized.
Following the unanimous vote to seek such affiliation, data sheets were distributed and pictures were requested.

November 4

Letters from faculty adviser sent to Brothers Thomson and Farrar advising them of the organization and developments of Beta Epsilon Tau.

November 9

Letter received from Brother Farrar advising Brother Ronnie Smith, District Director, had been informed of the local club projects.

November 11

Reply was made to the above letter giving progress made on petition and other projects.

November 13

Letter was sent to Brother Ronnie Smith to provide him with all details of local club activity - and inviting him to speak at our December meeting.

November 16

Letter sent by adviser (Perry Broom, member at the University of Texas) requesting life membership in Delta Sigma Pi.

November 18

A supplementary letter was mailed to Brother Smith advising him of club progress.

November 20

The following offices were filled:
Chancellor - Sam McWilliams
Senior Guide - Jack Pullen
Junior Guide - Charles May
Program Chairman - Prior Pickens
Ritual Chairman - Kenneth Jagers
Research Committee Chairman - William McGary

The membership chairman was instructed to prepare a program calendar for the balance of the 1959-60 school year, and make an announcement as soon as possible.

Mr. Ronnie Smith, District Director of Delta Sigma Pi, will be invited to speak to the club on December 10, 1959.

A program of research projects was approved by chapter vote. The suggested projects will include: (1) co-sponsorship of a management conference by or before 1961. (2) a survey to determine business opportunities for graduates in connection with a regional management development series. (3) a regional study of recent business developments in industry. (4) a series of field trips to nearby industry will be undertaken.

December 2

At a called business meeting the local constitution and by-laws were approved by formal vote. The secretary was instructed to forward a copy to the central office of Delta Sigma Pi.

The minimum scholastic average for local membership was set at 1.0 average grade points. However, all petitioning charter members must have an average which is equivalent to the average of all men business majors. This meets the recommendation of Delta Sigma Pi in this respect. This is equivalent to a C+ average. The standard of scholarship in the Business Administration Department is very high. During the past academic year, the department ranked first and third (for the two semesters respectively) among all the departments of the college--on the basis of actual grades made by students enrolled in classes.

The vice-president was instructed to start pledge instruction on the first Monday of each month (9:30 a.m. period). Douglas Cooper, Kenneth Pickett, and Michael White were appointed pledge captains.

A deadline of noon of December 7 was set for turning in personal data sheets and pictures for inclusion in the petition. The program committee announced that the following speakers would be invited for 1960 meetings. (1) The Honorable Sam Rayburn, Speaker of the House of Representatives. (2) R. L. Mullins, Past President, American Bankers Association, Wolfe City. (3) Arthur Smith, Economist, First National Bank, Dallas. (4) Patrick

Haggerty, Executive Vice-President, Texas Instruments, Inc., Dallas. (5) Dr. Watrous Irons, President, Federal Reserve Bank, Dallas. In addition, several panel discussions are planned in such fields as industrial relations, insurance, real estate, cost accounting, quality control, and operations research. The News Letter was discussed and authorized. Copies are to be mailed to alumni members.

December 7

A list of all members of Beta Epsilon Tau was sent to the central office of Delta Sigma Pi.

December 10

The regular meeting of Beta Epsilon Tau was held at the club room. Ronnie Smith, District Director of Delta Sigma Pi, spoke ably on the meaning of the national fraternity. The petitions were duly signed by all charter members.

December 14

The petitions were bound and mailed to the central office. A letter of clarification of all matters (to date) was mailed to the central office of Delta Sigma Pi also.



Gentlemen:

As chairman of the Department of Business Administration at East Texas State College I am wholeheartedly in favor of the decision of our local professional club, Beta Epsilon Tau, to seek affiliation with your organization.

There has been considerable interest among our majors for quite some time in the possibility of organizing a local professional club. The main reason for postponing action until now is that we wanted to wait until we were located in our new physical facilities. Since we are now comfortably and adequately housed in a new \$425,000 air-conditioned building, interest in the local club, with consequent interest in becoming affiliated with a leading national organization, is even greater than before.

Also, it is gratifying to observe that this endeavor has received the enthusiastic support of all faculty members in this department as well as that of all administrative officers of the college.

It is my understanding that other portions of the petitioning material will provide complete statistical data concerning the size and relative importance of the Department of Business Administration on this campus. Consequently, I shall simply observe in passing at this point that the department has grown steadily until now about one-fifth of all graduates are majors of this department. For example, in the 1958-'59 school year 514 Bachelor's degrees were conferred by this college; of these 91, or 18%, were business majors.
