## HISTORY OF WHEELING

Wheeling, West Virginia is located on the east bank of the Ohio River, 59 miles south of Pittsburgh.

In 1769 a group of white settlers consisting of Colonel Ebenezer Zane and his brothers Jonathan, Issac and Silas, took tomahawk possession<sup>1</sup> of what is now known as the Wheeling area. A settlement was made after the ratification of friendly relations between the Indians and the Settlers. In 1774 Chief Logan, of the Mingo tribe, and his family were massacred by a group of white settlers. The alliance of the Indians with the English thus took place, and a series of battles ensued, including two serious stormings of Fort Henry, then the only military stockade and protection for the pioneers. The last of these bloody conflicts took place in 1782 when Colonel Zane and his men defeated the main body of Indians.

According to the old legend, the name "Wheeling" originated from the Delaware Indians.

The existence of Wheeling as a town does not date back further than 1793, when the first lots, 112 in number, were laid out by Colonel Zane. In 1806, when the total population did not exceed a few hundred, a common council met and elected its officers. Wheeling became an incorporated city in 1836.

Wheeling is now a city of about 65,300 in population. It's trade consists of a number of chemical corporations, steel industries, glass making, etc.

## Points Of Interest

The suspension bridge, completed in 1850, was at one time the longest single span in the world. It measured 1,010 feet from the center of the span to the center of the supporting towers. In 1854 a strong wind overturned the structure but it was promptly rebuilt.

McCulloch's Leap, located at the top of Wheeling Hill on U. S. Route 40, is the site where Major Samuel McCulloch, pursued by a band of Indians during a raid in 1777, spurred his horse over the hillside to the banks of Wheeling Creek<sup>2</sup> nearly two hundred feet below. Horse and rider both survived and crossed the creek to escape. Major McCulloch was later killed by Indians not far from Fort Henry in 1782.

Fort Henry is located in downtown Wheeling. Here, the last battle of the American Revolution was fought. Today, all that remains of the Fort is a stone marker standing on the corner of Eleventh and Main Streets.

Oglebay Park, located in the hills surrounding Wheeling, exemplifies the fruition of one man's desire to give all of the people of Wheeling something beautiful, beneficial, entertaining and stimulating.

Oglebay Park comprises 800 acres of hills, woods, meadows and fields formerly known as Waddington Farm. By the terms of his will Mr. Oglebay for as long as the people "shall operate it for the purpose of public recreation and education", turned it over to the people of Wheeling.



Oglebay Institute provides leadership and opportunities in arts and crafts, music, drama and childrens theater, nature education, radio, audio-visual aids, museums, hobby clubs, vespers, summer concerts, and camps including folk dance, nature, and drum major. In one season more than 200,000 people participated in Institute sponsored programs.

## HISTORY OF WEST LIBERTY STATE COLLEGE

West Liberty State College had its first beginning in 1837, when the legislature of the Commonwealth of Virginia chartered West Liberty Academy. The Academy was, however, everything but what one would expect. The first classes were held in the home of a minister, the Rev. Nathan Shotwell. He taught the boys in one room of his home and his wife taught the girls in another. The beginning enrollment was sixty-five.

The course of study consisted largely of Algebra, Latin, Oil Painting, and Music. Logic, Arithmetic, and Geometry were also taught.

Rev. Shotwell remained with the Academy until 1844 or 1845. The Academy, because of acute financial problems, was sold in 1867 to the new state of West Virginia.

On March 1, 1870, "An act to establish a branch Normal School at West Liberty" was passed. This action resulted in the first session of the normal school being held on May 2, 1870. This was one of the first three schools of higher learning originally planned by the State of West Virginia.

On March 4, 1931, the West Virginia legislature passed a bill changing the name from "normal" to "teachers"; this resulted in the school's being known as "West Liberty State Teacher's College."

During the period of 1908 to 1919 over 100 acres of land were acquired, which constitutes our campus today with a few additions. The first building to be built on this land was Shaw Hall, a three-story brick structure designed to accommodate one hundred and two girls. Shaw Hall, completed in 1920, also includes kitchens and dining rooms.

In 1929 \$100,000 was appropriated for the construction of two wings of the main administration building. Curtis Hall and McColloch Hall are those two wings, and they are the two primary academic buildings on campus today.

By the end of 1936 a new \$65,000 men's dormitory, Shotwell Hall, was completed, and in 1943 the college attained its present name: West Liberty State College.

West Liberty State College has grown at a rapid rate in recent years, as may be best witnessed by the vast building program. The present school auditorium was completed in 1951 at a cost of \$250,000. The auditorium, named College Hall, is outfitted with a nine foot and seven foot grand piano, and with a concert model Hammond organ. It is also completely equipped for major dramatic productions.

In March, 1953, \$500,000 was appropriated for the construction of a new Health and Physical Education building. This was completed in 1955, and a \$100,000 classroom addition has since been added.

During 1956 the legislature appropriated \$250,000 for a new student union. This fine building, called the Center, was finished in March, 1959, and is complete in every detail.

A new women's dormitory, Rogers Hall, was approved in October, 1957, and was completed in time for the school year beginning in September, 1958. This building cost \$820,000.

The center wing of the main academic building, which will be named Main Hall, was finally approved on March 15, 1960. This building, to be built at a cost of \$1,200,000, will join Curtis and McColloch Halls.

The enrollment of the college has been increasing in a "never-anticipated" amount. In 1951 the enrollment was 513; in 1954 it jumped to 753; and in 1956 849 attended the college. Over 1,000 enrolled in September of 1959. Not included in these figures are the students at the Downtown Center, which is located in nearby Wheeling. The Downtown Center operates for the advantage of the "working people" who desire to take college courses at night.





## HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS

The Department of Business was founded in 1943. Since that time it has been expanding rapidly, so much so that today it has the highest percentage of total enrollment of the college. An additional professor was added to the Department in September, 1959.

The aims of the Department are the following:

1. To guide students into an appropriate vocational choice, especially within the area of business.
2. To build vocational competency upon a sound foundation of general education.
3. To create an atmosphere in which students will learn to solve problems, seek the truth, and develop questioning attitudes.
4. To help develop good character and to prepare for effective citizenship in a democratic country.
5. To provide the necessary skills and attitudes to equip the student for positions in business and business education.
6. To develop an appreciation for integrity in both personal and business life.

A student may enroll in a vocational or general business; four-year accounting; personnel management, marketing, and salesmanship; four-year secretarial; two-year accounting; or two-year secretarial curriculum. The vocational and general business curricula, both for business education students, lead to an A. B. degree, while the Personnel, four-year secretarial, and four-year accounting curricula lead to a B. S. degree.




