



## HISTORY

The completion of the St. Louis-Brownsville-Mexico Railroad from Houston to Brownsville five years after the turn of the century opened up a vast area of South Texas to an era of rapid settlement and development. Before a decade had passed, a movement had begun to provide for the training of an adequate number of teachers to serve the educational needs of such a rapidly growing region. Following an organized campaign by pioneer educators and civic-minded citizens, the State Legislature enacted a law in April, 1917, to provide for the creation and establishment of a coeducational South Texas Normal School. The law provided for a locating committee, who should immediately begin a canvass of the field. Another section of the law provided for a specified appropriation for the erection, equipment, and maintenance of the institution for the fiscal year ending August 31, 1919.

On July 14, 1917, the locating committee completed its assignment by announcing the selection of Kingsville as the site of the new school. Meanwhile the entrance of the United States into World War I delayed the implementation of other provisions of the law. The third called session of the Thirty-Fifth Legislature repealed all appropriations made for any and all purposes of the newly created educational institution for the duration of the war. Progress toward the establishment of the South Texas school was not resumed until 1923. In April of that year a bill became law by which all state normal schools were changed to state teachers colleges.

The Thirty-Eighth Legislature, having accepted the land site of the college as a deed gift from the citizens of Kingsville, made an appropriation for the erection of the main building and the president's home and for their equipment and maintenance for the biennium of 1923-25.

The first academic building was accepted May 26, 1925, and South Texas State Teachers College became a functioning institution in June, 1925. Before five years had elapsed, however, there had developed an urgent need for a major institution of higher learning that would more adequately serve an area with such an increasing population and diversified economy. To meet this need, citizens of vision joined with leading schoolmen to promote a technological college for South Texas. By January, 1929, Senate Bill 293 had been introduced in the Legislature; on March 26, 1929, it was signed by the Governor. This bill changed the name of the South Texas State Teachers College to the Texas College of Arts and Industries and at the same time enlarged the purpose and scope of the college. Although the services of the institution were thus broadened, the teacher-training function was not reduced or impaired.

A section of the bill designated four major divisions: Liberal Arts, Industrial Arts and Commerce, Education, and Military Science. Another section provided for a board of nine directors to manage the affairs of the College, independent of all other boards of state-supported schools. Since then the College has made continuous progress in its physical plant, technological development, and scholastic recognition. In the fall term of 1935 The Board of Directors authorized the organization of a Graduate Division offering work leading to the degrees of Master of Arts and Master of Science.

Effective September 1, 1947, the College was reorganized into six divisions: Agriculture, Arts and Sciences, Business Administration, Engineering, Teacher Education, and Graduate Studies.

The Board of Directors has negotiated contracts with the Veterans Administration to educate and train veterans in accordance with specifications set forth in Public Laws 16, 346, 550, and 894.

## FACTS ABOUT TEXAS COLLEGE OF ARTS AND INDUSTRY

Texas College of Arts and Industries is a state supported coeducational college with a student body of 4,231 ( fall semester enrollment, 1964) and a faculty of about 200 men and women. The student-faculty ratio is approximately 20 to 1. About 40 per cent of the regular faculty members hold doctor's degrees.

The college has the advantage of being small enough to permit a close faculty-student relationship and large enough to offer a comprehensive program of academic studies and extra curricular activities.

About 40 buildings comprise the main campus. Major buildings are of Spanish architecture.

Texas A & I has six divisions: Agriculture, Arts and Sciences, Business Administration, Engineering, Teacher Education, and Graduate Studies.


School publications include The South Texan, the student newspaper, and El Rancho, the college yearbook.


#### THE STUDENT UNION BUILDING


#### EDWARD NEWTON JONES AUDITORIUM

Edward Newton Jones Auditorium, erected in 1942, is recognized as one of the most beautiful buildings in South Texas. It has a seating capacity of 1,450, is equipped with indirect lighting, and has unusually fine acoustics. It is appointed with blue upholstered seats and maroon and blue hangings.



#### ADMINISTRATION AND LIBRARY BUILDING

Erected in 1951, it is a two-story air conditioned building built of brick and tile. It faces a beautifully landscaped boulevard. In it are located the library with spacious and well-lighted reading rooms and the administrative offices.

#### FINE ARTS CENTER

The Frank C. Smith Fine Arts Center is composed of three buildings: an Art Building, a Music Building, and a Speech Building. All three were erected in 1959. They contain classrooms, studios, practice rooms, recital halls, and offices. A spacious recital hall is located in the Music Building; a little theatre and dramatics auditorium is in the Speech Building; and a beautifully arranged gallery is located in the Arts Building.

## DIVISION OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

At Texas College of Arts and Industries the division of Business Administration offers degrees in any one of five different fields. These include a general B.B.A. degree and the B.B.A. degree with a major in accounting, finance, management, or marketing.

The college has recently acquired two computers. The Division of Business Administration is offering sufficient work in data processing to meet the needs of its majors. Other courses will be added as work in this field is expanded.

A student majoring in marketing at Texas A & I takes courses which are designed to provide him with the necessary foundation upon which to build his marketing career. The aim is to develop his understanding of both how and why the numerous marketing activities are performed.

The Texas A & I accounting department offers a wide variety of accounting courses to the business student who majors in this area of business. Courses are offered in elementary, intermediate, cost, governmental, and petroleum accounting as well as income tax and auditing. In each of these courses the students are required to work assignment problems and practice sets that help illustrate the fundamentals of the course. The courses are designed to give each student a thorough knowledge of accounting and the role it plays in today's business world. The accounting graduate has a background which makes him available for immediate employment or if he desires to continue his studies on a graduate level, he can.

The goal of almost every accounting student is to become a Certified Public Accountant. The instruction offered at Texas A & I, in addition to building a broad base upon which a person can build his future profession, is oriented

toward preparing the student for the "CPA Exams" and enabling him to become a Certified Public Accountant soon after graduation.

The study of Management may be divided into two areas: Personnel management and general management.

The college graduate specializing in personnel management may find employment opportunity as an understudy in the personnel department of various kinds of organizations, such as business, government and non-profit institutions. Others may become personnel directors for a small business or may be recruited as trainees in pre-management training programs.

The general management program provides an opportunity for the student to develop his ability to carry out the management functions at all levels in an organization. Specific emphasis is placed upon forecasting, planning, organizing, staffing, and controlling.

## HISTORY OF DELTA SIGMA TAU FRATERNITY

During the Spring Semester of 1965 the Delta Sigma Tau Fraternity was founded on the Texas A & I campus. Several organization and introductory meetings were held in late February and in March the first slate of officers was elected.

From the beginning the main objective of the Fraternity was to fulfill the requirements necessary to become a chapter of the International Fraternity of Delta Sigma Pi. Work was begun immediately on the petition to Delta Sigma Pi. The By-laws and Constitution of Delta Sigma Tau were modeled after those of a typical Delta Sigma Pi chapter, and are being developed to provide the members with a broader knowledge of business and to foster brotherhood among the members. So far the activities of the Fraternity have consisted of business meetings and a professional dinner meeting.

Delta Sigma Tau has received notice in the school newspaper, and interest is high among the members. All the members are eagerly looking forward to becoming a chapter of Delta Sigma Pi and growing into the leading business fraternity on the A & I campus.
