HISTORY OF PENSACOLA

(The City of Five Flags)

The name Pensacola has been thought of as having two different origins. Some believe that the city was named for a village in Spain called Pensicola. Others believe that it was taken from the Indian name for the Spaniards, Pazacola, meaning "hairy-faced".

The city of Pensacola was first founded by the Spanish in 1559, six years before the settlement of St. Augustine. Unlike St. Augustine, however, Pensacola did not become a permanent settlement. Two years later Pensacola was abandoned due to dissension among the inhabitants. In 1696 the Spanish again settled the city and made it a permanent settlement, after recognizing the advantages of the sheltered deep-water port.

In 1719, Pensacola was captured by the French -- then at war with Spain. Two years later the Spanish again gained control of the city. Pensacola remained in the hands of the Spanish until, as a result of European agreement, it passed into the hands of the British. In 1781, it was again returned to the control of the Spanish.

In 1821 Florida was ceded to the United States and Andrew Jackson, the first Governor of Florida, took possession in the city of

Pensacola. For some years it remained the capital, since Pensacola was the largest city in Florida.

The Federal Government, realizing the importance of the harbor at Pensacola, improved upon the fortifications left by the Spaniards. Fort Pickens was built in 1829 at the harbor entrance, which provided the only protection to the bay entrance until the completion of Fort Barrancas in 1850.

During the Civil War the federal forces kept a firm hold on Fort Pickens and denied the Confederacy the use of the finest deep-water port in the South. After several futile assaults on Santa Rosa Island failed to dislodge the federal forces from Fort Pickens, the Confederate forces abandoned Pensacola in 1862.

After the Civil War, the city of Pensacola became the lumber port of the South. Not only was Pensacola important as a port of trade, but it also became a United States Naval Base. In the first quarter of this century, Pensacola was made famous by the Navy. It has become the center of all Naval Air Training, and at present is the home of the world famous "Blue Angels". The Navy at Pensacola is also known for turning out the finest helicopter pilots in the world.

Pensacola, since the Second World War, has become host to many diversified industries. Monsanto Corporation, St. Regis Paper Company, Westinghouse Electric Corporation and various smaller

industries have located in Pensacola in order to take advantage of the large supplies of water, favorable weather conditions and transportation facilities that are available throughout the metropolitan area.

For the people of Pensacola there is always something to do or a place to go during their leisure time. The beaches, movie theaters, country clubs or the jumping night spots are available to the young, middle-aged and the senior citizen.

HISTORY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA

In 1967 funds were authorized by the State Legislature for the establishment of the University of West Florida and its operations to begin in September of 1967. In the fall of 1963, the Board of Control approved the sites for the main 1,000-acre campus and an auxiliary campus on Santa Rosa Island.

This includes 23 graduate students, but does not include 956 students enrolled in off-campus courses.

The University of West Florida is in itself an impressive sight. The initial campus building program, representing an investment of approximately \$17,000,000, includes a five-floor main library, an administration-classroom complex, a humanities building, a science complex, an audio-visual building, three office-classroom buildings,

a students commons building which provides rooms and offices for the dining hall, game rooms, campus doctor and a cafeteria for commuting students.

Now entering its second year of operation, the University of West Florida publicizes itself as a unique institution. It is an upper-level university that admits only junior and senior students. The University is set apart from other colleges by its building design and internal structure. Both try to encourage education excellence. The University of West Florida's administrative structure borrowed and made its own British-Cambridge concept of resident colleges within a university.

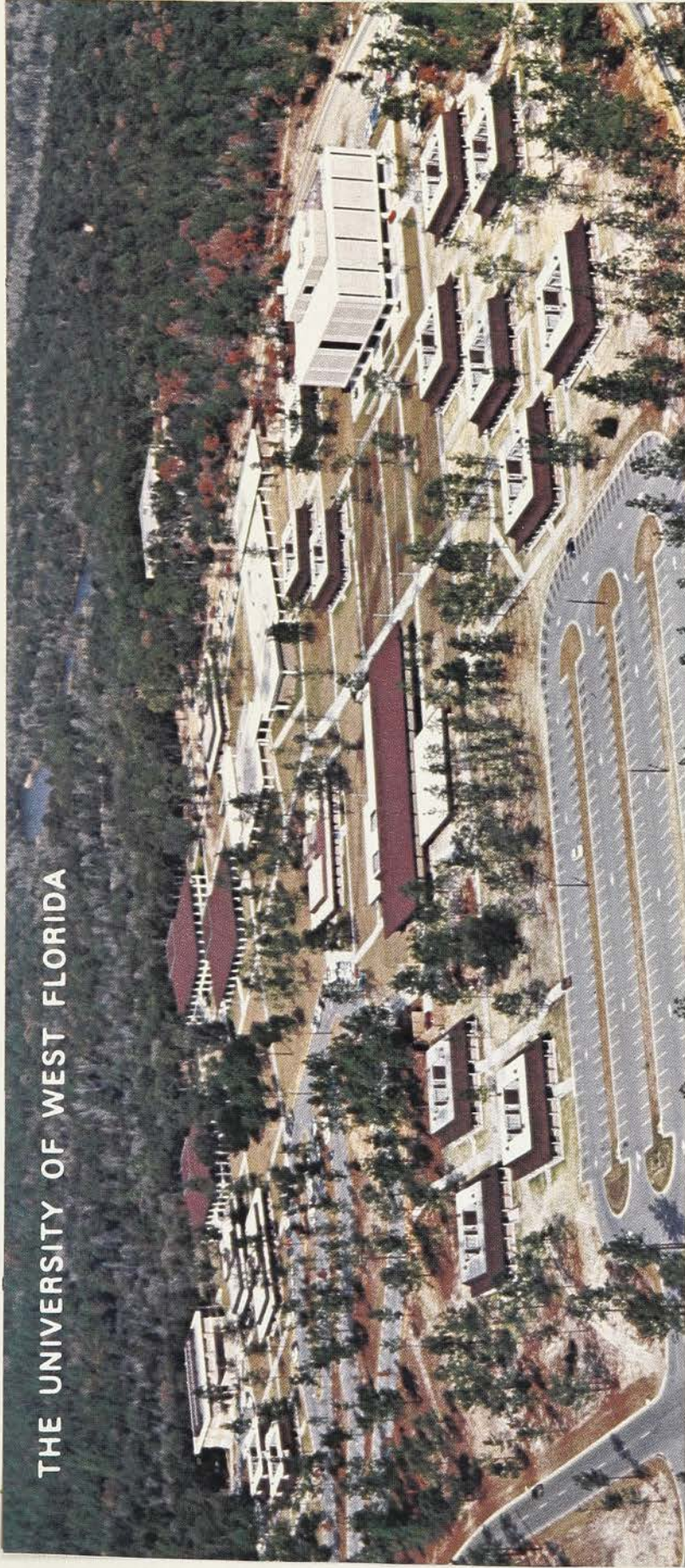
The University of West Florida opened with three resident colleges -- Alpha, Gamma and Omega. When currently-planned construction is completed, each will have its own separate building arranged as a village. Additional buildings are at several stages of planning and construction to accommodate the expected enrollment increases. A 1975 ceiling of 10,000 students was established by the Board of Regents for the new upper-level university. The University of West Florida is a growing university and the students and faculty play an important part in helping this university fulfill its goals.

Accreditation is one of these goals. The University of West Florida is accredited by the Florida State Department of Education

and is a member of the State University System. The University is in its second year and has been awarded the status of recognized candidate for accreditation. The institutional analysis, which is preparatory to full accreditation, is proceeding on schedule.

Those in orange are either under construction or currently on the drawing boards.

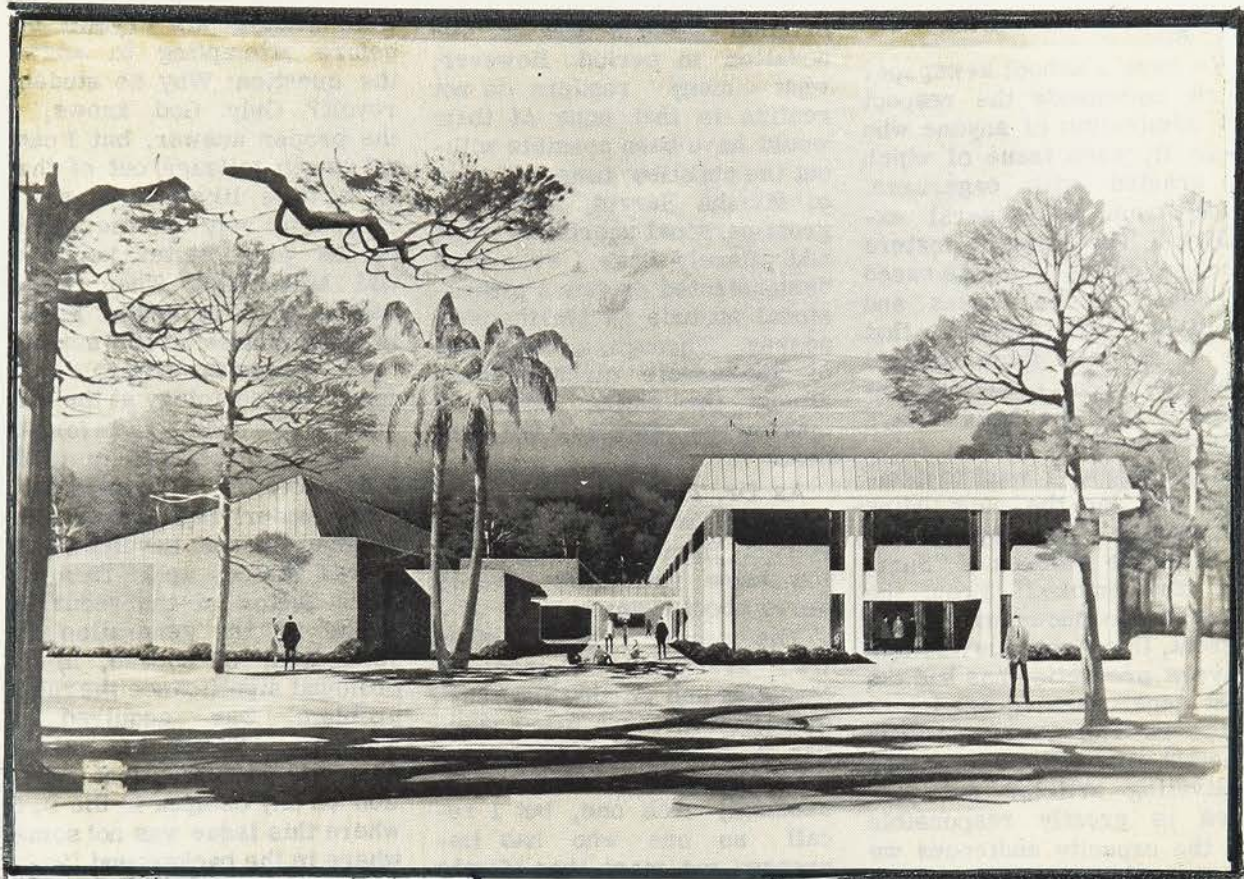
The yellow areas represent facilities that are planned for completion by 1975.

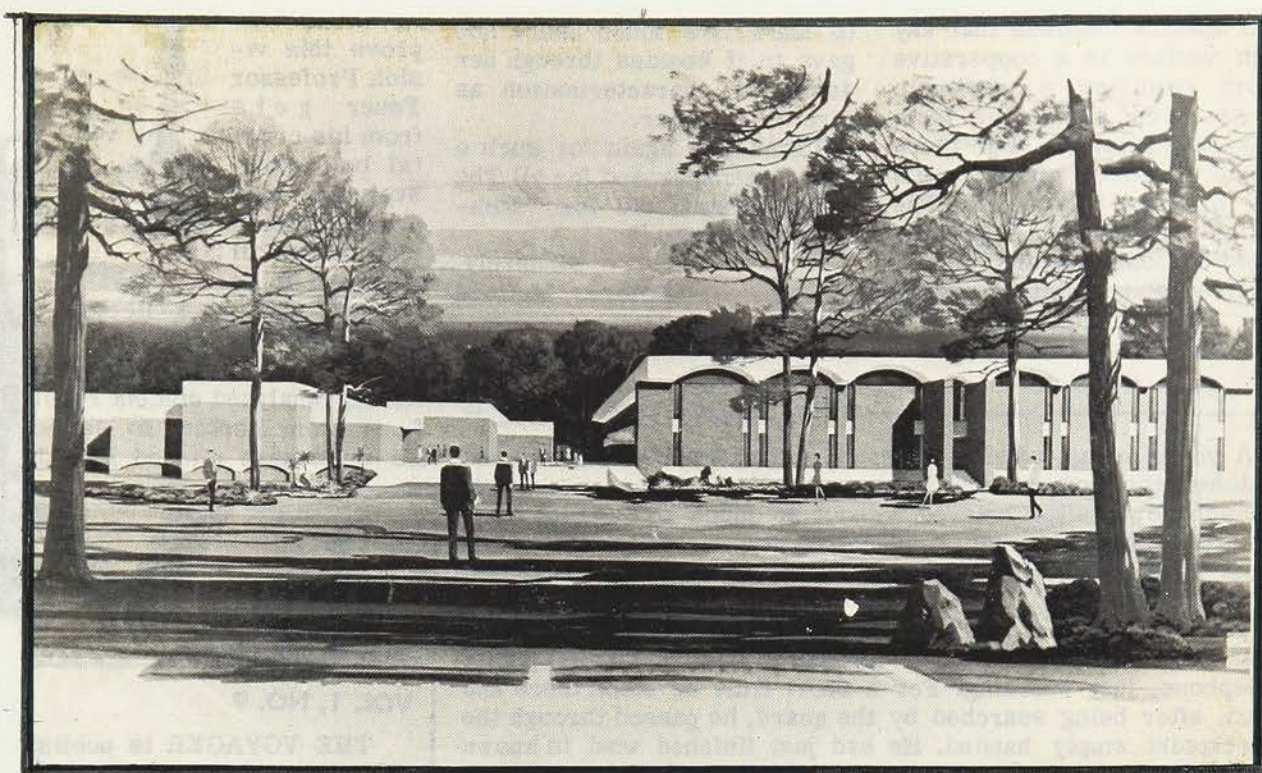

Alpha complex

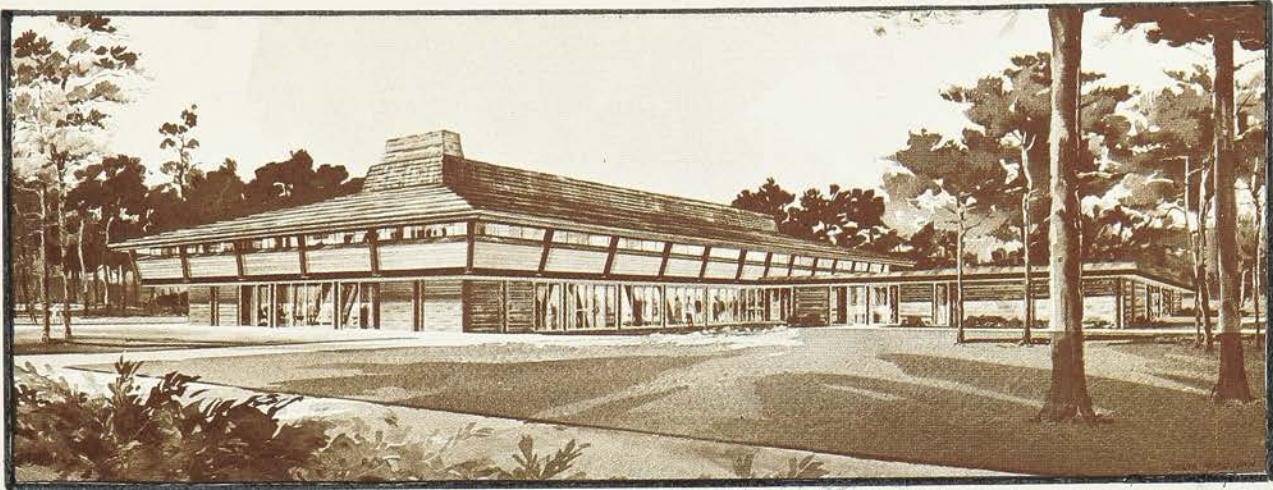
The contract for this portion of the Alpha College Complex has been let and work is now in progress. Occupancy is expected by the Winter quarter of 1970. Alpha College houses the Marketing Department as well as Education, Math, and Psychology. Alpha College now shares the Gamma Complex with Gamma and Omega College. The current trend of modern buildings will be carried through to the Alpha Complex with each College having a particular style of architecture each related to the other.

The Commons Building at West Florida is the center of all social activity. Work on the Omega Complex began this month with an expected occupancy date of September, 1969. Omega houses the largest number of business majors in Management and also Economics. Sharing Omega with the business students are art majors, physics, industrial technology, and political science. The Provost of Omega College will head the program for the Masters in Business Administration starting in September of this year.

Offices related to the students needs as housing, deans, and student special interest groups are located on the second floor along with a large student lounge. The main dining hall serves currently as an auditorium for entertainment groups seating more than 800.

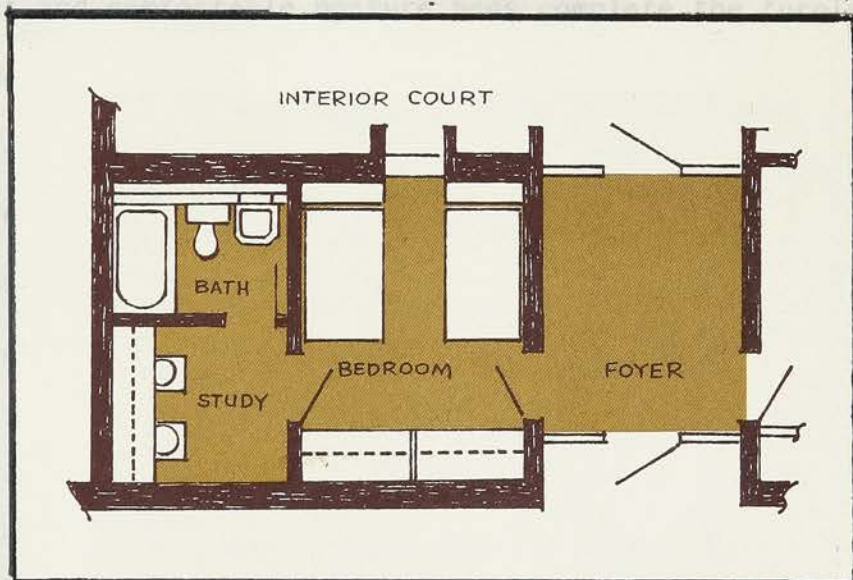


COMMONS BUILDING

The Commons Building at West Florida is the center of all social activity. The main dining hall, towering more than 30 feet in the center, creates an atmosphere of modern elegance with heavy wood beams amid a campus of concrete and steel. An adjacent snack bar with a soon to be beer hall is located in the West wing along with the campus nurse. The East wing houses the University Pool Room which offers pool, ping pong, bridge, and other games as well as television to the students. Offices related to the students needs as housing, deans, and student special interest groups are located on the second floor along with a large student lounge. The main dining hall serves currently as an auditorium for entertainment groups seating more than 800.

CAMPUS LIVING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA

Campus residents at The University of West Florida are involved in a unique experiment in on-campus living in the Florida University System. Designed around an interior courtyard, each cottage consists of sixteen, two-student suites. A foyer-lounge connects each unit of four suites with an outside veranda and the courtyard. For added convenience, each cottage offers laundry facilities, a baggage storeroom and vending machines to dispense that midnight snack. Telephones are located in the Lounges— one for each two suites. Convenient parking lots provide ample space for student automobiles near each cottage cluster.

A bedroom, study, and bath comprise the air-conditioned and carpeted suite. Built-in desk, bookcases and study lamp, together with comfortable swivel chairs, provide the best possible facilities for studying. Built-in wardrobes and comfortable posture beds complete the furnishings.

Residence halls are scattered throughout the campus mixing the academic buildings and residence buildings blending them creating a unity among the different phases of college life. Informal air-conditioned carpeted study areas are provided around the campus for those students not in residence and for coed studying.

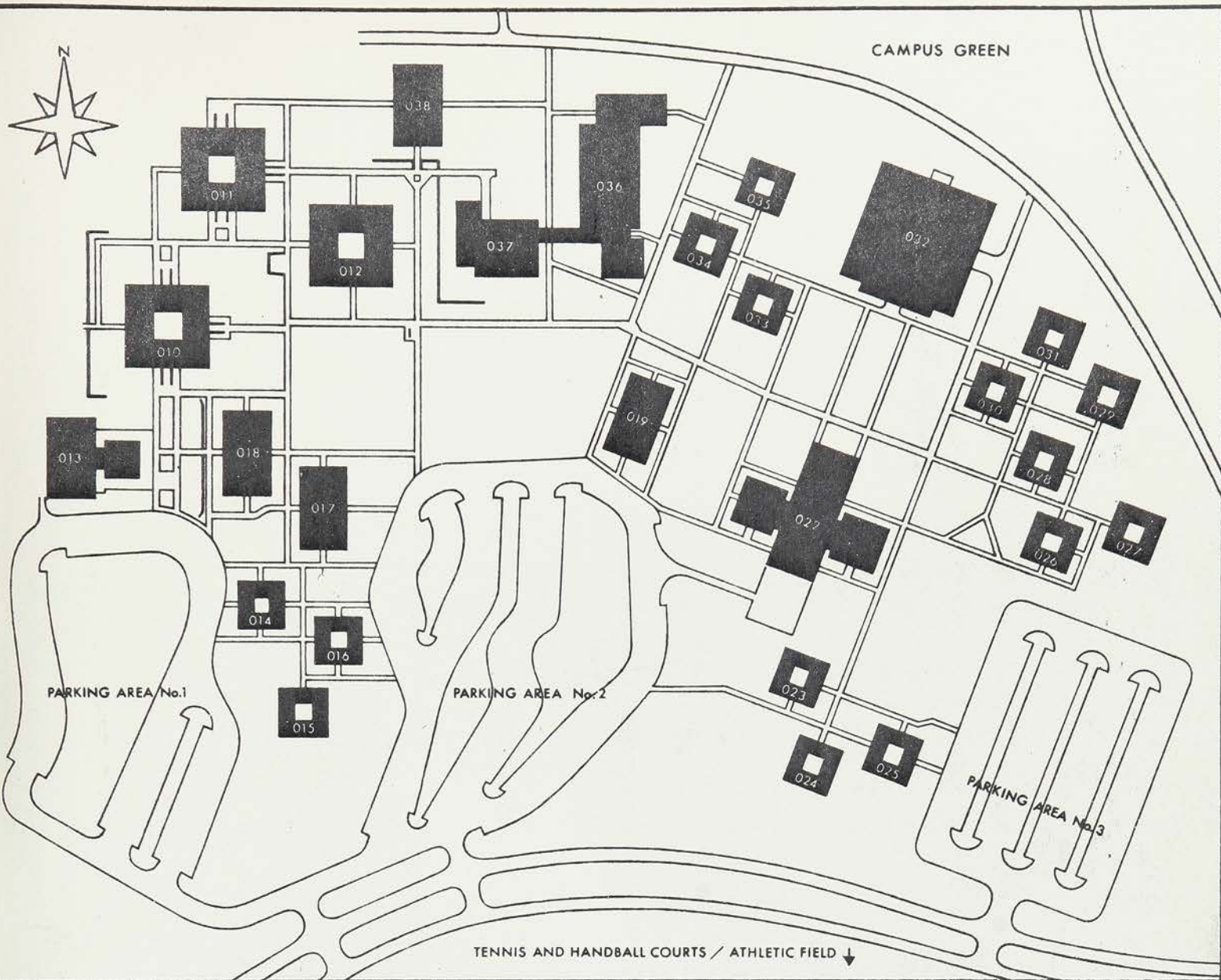

HISTORY AND FACTS OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AT UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA

The University of West Florida, with its unique three-college system, does not provide for an actual School of Business Administration and Commerce. The areas of business are divided among the three resident colleges to allow the student to become acquainted with persons in addition to his own, thereby further increasing his well-rounded education at the University.

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AND COMMERCE

Each college is headed by a president and each department chairman may have both formal and related department chairmen in other colleges.

The Alpha complex houses the Marketing Department headed by the well-qualified Dr. Robert B. Hays. The University, beginning in the fall of 1959, will offer a B.S. degree in marketing. Formerly a B.S. degree in management was offered in this field with emphasis on marketing. Today there are about 10 marketing majors and with each semester, new students pour into the Marketing Department.

The Gamma complex houses the Finance and Accounting Departments. This discipline is headed by the very well-known Dr.

HISTORY AND FACTS OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION AT UNIVERSITY OF WEST FLORIDA

The University of West Florida, with its unique three-college system, does not provide for an actual School of Business department's courses. Each quarter men of outstanding reputation, Administration and Commerce. The areas of business are divided among the three resident colleges to allow the student to become acquainted with persons in disciplines other than his own, thereby

further increasing his well-rounded education at the University.

The three resident colleges, Alpha, Gamma and Omega house the 2600 students divided into 500, 1300, and 800 respectively. Each college is headed by a provost and each department chairman may have both formal and informal ties with similarly related department chairmen in other colleges.

The Alpha complex houses the Marketing Department headed by the well-qualified Dr. Robert E. Karp. The University, beginning in the fall of 1969, will offer a B.S. degree in marketing. Formerly a B.S. degree in management was offered in this field with emphasis on marketing. Today there are about 40 marketing majors and with each quarter, new students pour into the Marketing Department.

The Gamma complex holds the Finance and Accounting Departments. This discipline is headed by the very well-known Dr.

Thomas C. Committee. There are about 125 accounting and 35 finance majors. Each of these majors receives a highly diversified education in related fields of Economics, General Business, Data Processing, Report Writing and Tax Law, as well as into the entire department's courses. Each quarter men of outstanding reputation, ability, and educational experience join the department, further increasing the already superior staff.

The Omega complex houses the Economics, Business Administration in Management, and Systems Science Departments. The Economics Department of the University has many top-name instructors with backgrounds ranging from a presidential advisor to a stockbroker, giving the student of economics a varied influence on his attitudes. The Department Chairman, Dr. Pedro C. M. Teichert, is a highly-praised educator and administrator and is the author of many books concerning South American Economics.

The Business Administration and Management staff, the largest of the related business departments, is headed by Dr. Richard C. Einbecker, formerly an executive with several of the top U.S. companies. Dr. Einbecker, with his practical background in American business, is able to coordinate and administer his department to acquaint his students with the realities of business as they will find it outside the gates of the University. Upon the opening of the University

in September, 1967, there were only two management instructors for over 300 students, the demand being heavily under-estimated by the administration. Today, the department of over 350 students has approximately 25 highly qualified instructors, each a leading educator, industrialist or administrator in his own field with a high majority having at least one doctorate.

The Systems Science discipline falls under the Industrial Technology Department headed by Dr. Wendell L. Roy, with the Data Processing courses falling under the direction of Mr. Robert E. Littleton. Mr. Littleton is more than adequately informed, with a half dozen Masters Degrees in related fields. Mr. Littleton requires each Systems Science graduate to have a well-diversified, integrated education including Accounting, Economics, Management and Math. With our highly related business interest, we of Alpha Beta Alpha have accepted these business-oriented Systems Science majors as brothers.

The three-college system, while being highly effective in offering the student a well-rounded education and diversely influenced environment, does increase the need for a professional, less formal relationship between the business discipline students. Each major crosses the resident college boundaries for at least 35 to 40 percent of his courses. Consequently, the different business departments are

heavily integrated. A business fraternity would benefit both the University and the business student tremendously. With these qualities, even without a business department per se, we expect local interest to flourish.

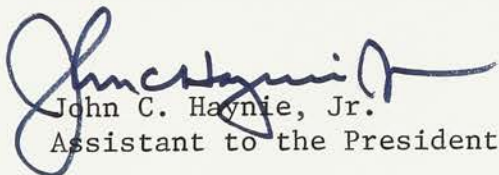

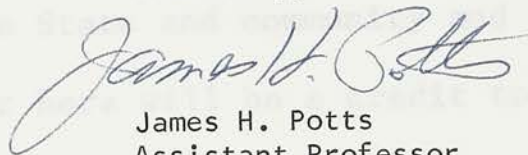
