

From 1958 to 1972 the School was known as San Fernando Valley State College. In 1972, having met the criteria set by the CSUC Board of Trustees, it became California State University, Northridge. California State University, Northridge offers bachelor's degrees in 48 subjects and master's in 37 areas as well as degree programs in the technology-

CSUN has a combined undergraduate and graduate student enrollment of more than 27,000 and a faculty of more than 1,500. Many of the faculty members have gained national recognition for research work in scientific and scholarly fields. The faculty includes many published authors, as well as nationally recognized artists and musicians.

The University environment includes more than a dozen modern and spacious buildings and many lesser structures situated in a beautifully landscaped campus. Major buildings include the University Student Union, Oviatt Library, Student Health Center, Engineering, Science, Speech-Drama, Music, Fine Arts, South Library, Education (Monterey Hall), Cafeteria/Matador Bookstore, Physical Education and Gymnasium, and Administration, as well as Sierra Hall, a large classroom complex housing many faculty offices. CSUN's \$2 million San Fernando Observatory, situated near the campus, is available for advanced solar research.

Most of the students at the University come from Los Angeles and Ventura counties, but virtually every other part of California, most of the other states, and some 57 foreign countries are represented in the student body. The students represent a wide variety of academic interests, socio-economic and ethnic backgrounds, and cultural and recreational preferences.

While the freshman class consists primarily of recent high school graduates, there is great diversity at other class levels. Approximately one-fourth of the students are married. More than half are employed on a part-time or full-time basis.

California State University, Northridge offers bachelor's degrees in 48 subjects and master's in 37 areas as well as degree programs in the technological and professional fields.

The University is divided into eight schools: Art, Business Administration and Economics, Communication and Professional Studies, Education, Engineering and Computer Science, Humanities, Science and Mathematics, and Social and Behavioral Science.


CSUN is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and by the California State Board of Education.







History of the School of Business Administration and Economics

Following the establishment of San Fernando Valley State College in July of 1958 and SFVSC's transformation to California State University, Northridge in 1972, the School of Business Administration and Economics has been in existence since 1964.

Today, the students of Business Administration and Economics account for approximately 5,000 of the total University's population of 28,000 students and 3,100 full-time enrollment compared to the 19,800 total full-time enrollment of the University.

The School of Business Administration and Economics offers a diverse curriculum ranging from the theoretical to the professional to the practical. Eight academic departments offer programs in accounting, economics, finance, real estate and insurance, management, management science, marketing, office administration and business education.

To provide an optimum program, the School offers three undergraduate degrees: a B.S. in Business Education, for students who intend to teach business subjects; a B.A. in Economics, for those who desire a liberal arts education with the emphasis on economics and related fields; and a B.S. in Business Administration, which provides an overview of the basic business fields.

Three graduate degrees are also offered. The Master of Science degree in Business Administration permits specialization in accounting, business education, finance, management, management science, marketing and office administration.

The Master of Business Administration and Master of Public Administration degrees are professional-degree programs designed for students with a baccalaureate degree in a field other than administration.

The Bureau of Business Services and Research was organized to serve the needs of students, faculty and the San Fernando Valley business community. The Bureau provides leadership and planning through conferences and seminars, and sponsors a variety of career and continuing-education courses and workshops.

In addition, the Bureau coordinates and initiates research within the fields of business and economics and compiles applicable local and regional data.

Another vital link to the business world is the Advisory Board/Business Community Resource Group. The Board serves both as a liaison and a source of expertise. Top-level executives participate in on-campus seminars and are available for counseling and guidance.

Members of the Business Community Resource Group include representatives from the fields of accounting, law, economics, marketing, insurance, medicine, aerospace, public administration and international diplomacy.

In cooperation with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), the unique Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program was begun at CSUN in 1970. VITA students prepare tax returns for low-income families, the elderly and the disadvantaged. Interpreters are provided for the non-English-speaking and the deaf. CSUN has the largest VITA program in the nation and has been commended by the IRS.

The School of Business Administration and Economics Council (SOBEC) provides leadership training for students. SOBEC, the student government body, is led by an elected senator who represents business and economics students on the all-University Associated Students Senate.

Business students are encouraged by the School to take part in the many and varied social contact opportunities with professionals in the various fields of study. Student clubs and associations are microcosms of the real world, and teach management techniques and organizational behavior.
