



## HISTORY OF CORPUS CHRISTI STATE UNIVERSITY

Corpus Christi State University was chartered in June 1973 under the name, Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi. The charter was authorized by the 63rd Legislature of the State of Texas by House Bill 278. The institution was established in Section 1 of this bill as a fully state-supported educational institution of higher learning. The institution shall be organized to accept only junior, senior, and graduate level students with at least sixty (60) semester hours of accredited college or university study.

The campus is located on 223.5 acres of land surrounded by the waters of Corpus Christi Bay and San Bay. This site was deeded to the State after the citizens of Corpus Christi passed a \$1.5 million bond issue which was utilized to clear the indebtedness of the former University of Corpus Christi that was then located on the site. On June 1, 1973, the site officially became the campus of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi.

### HISTORY OF CORPUS CHRISTI STATE UNIVERSITY

Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi was one of the Texas A&I University System, which was governed by an appointed Board of Directors. The other members of the system were Texas A&I University at Kingsville, and Texas A&I University at Laredo.

On September 1, 1977 the Legislature of the State of Texas passed House Bill 944 which changed the Texas A&I University System to the University System of South Texas. House Bill 944 also changed the name of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi to Corpus Christi State University.

When the University first opened its doors to students in September 1973, 273 students enrolled for classes. The University had 40 faculty members. In the Fall semester of 1979, over 2,700 students were enrolled and the faculty had grown to 150.

The University is located on a 250 acre island campus. Approximately 220 million of new construction has been completed since the University began in 1973.

The University now offers 22 baccalaureate degrees and 10 master degree programs. A Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree and a Master of Public Administration Degree are planned for the future.

## HISTORY OF CORPUS CHRISTI STATE UNIVERSITY

Corpus Christi State University was chartered in June 1971, under the name, Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi. This charter was authorized by the 62nd Legislature of the State of Texas by House Bill 275. On June 1, 1973, the site officially became the campus of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi.

Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi was a part of the Texas A&I University System, which was governed by an appointed Board of Directors. The other members of the system were Texas A&I University at Kingsville, and Texas A&I University at Laredo.

On September 1, 1977 the Legislature of the State of Texas passed House Bill 944 which changed the Texas A&I University System to the University System of South Texas. House Bill 944 also changed the name of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi to Corpus Christi State University.

The University now offers 22 baccalaureate degrees and 10 master degree programs. A Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree and a Master of Public Administration Degree are planned for the future.

## HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The College of Business Administration was established in 1948 as a result of the merger of the Department of Business Administration and the Department of Economics. The College is a part of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

The College of Business Administration offers the BBA degree with concentrations in Accounting, Finance, General Business, Human Resources Management, International Management, Marketing and Management Information Systems. The College also offers the MBA degree and courses in Public Administration which can be taken as a part of the MBA program.

The college is actively involved with continuing education for the business and industry community. Special relationships with the local and regional community in the Small Business Administration offer unique opportunities for students in the College of Business.

### HISTORY OF COLLEGE OF BUSINESS

The Department of Business Administration has achieved significant recognition. All students have always scored well above the state average in successfully passing the State CPA examination. ## HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION









In February, Phi Chi Psi took advantage of its opportunity to raise money by selling carnations in various arrangements to be delivered on Valentine's Day. Phi Chi Psi's carnation sale not only served to bring funds into the organization, it also served as publicity for the club.

Phi Chi Psi has a future as well as a past. March is the planning period to finalize details on: the popular Business Week activities on campus, sale of raffle tickets to raise funds; and the installation banquet planned for May 3, 1980. Phi Chi Psi begins its pledge program on March 25.



## HISTORY OF CORPUS CHRISTI STATE UNIVERSITY

## HISTORY OF CORPUS CHRISTI STATE UNIVERSITY

Corpus Christi State University was chartered in June 1971, under the name, Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi. This charter was authorized by the 62nd Legislature of the State of Texas by House Bill 275. The institution was established in Section I of this bill as ". . . a fully state-supported coeducational institution of higher learning . . . . The institution shall be organized to accept only junior, senior, and graduate level students, with at least sixty (60) semester hours of accredited college or university study."

The campus is located on 239.5 acres of land surrounded by the waters of Corpus Christi Bay and Oso Bay. This site was deeded to the State after the citizens of Corpus Christi passed a \$1.5 million bond issue which was utilized to clear the indebtedness of the former University of Corpus Christi that was then located on the site. On June 1, 1973, the site officially became the campus of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi.

Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi was a part of the Texas A&I University System, which was governed by an appointed Board of Directors. The other members of the system were Texas A&I University at Kingsville, and Texas A&I University at Laredo.

On September 1, 1977 the Legislature of the State of Texas passed House Bill 944 which changed the Texas A&I University System to the University System of South Texas. House Bill 944 also changed the name of Texas A&I University at Corpus Christi to Corpus Christi State University.

When the University first opened its doors to students in September 1973, 975 students enrolled for classes. The University had 40 faculty members. In the Fall Semester of 1979, over 2,700 students were enrolled and the faculty had grown to 100.

The University is located on a 250 acre island campus. Approximately \$20 million of new construction has been completed since the University began in 1973.

The University now offers 22 baccalaureate degrees and 10 master degree programs. A Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree and a Master of Public Administration Degree are planned for the future.

## HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The College of Business Administration originally began with a five person faculty when the University opened in September 1973. The college presently has a 22 member faculty and its combined undergraduate and graduate enrollment is now the largest of the four colleges in the University.

The College of Business Administration offers the BBA degree with concentrations in Accounting, Computer Applications, General Business, Finance, Management, Personnel Management, Marketing and Occupational Management. The college also offers the MBA degree and courses in Public Administration which can be taken as a part of the MBA program.

The college is actively involved with continuing education for the business and industry community. Formal relationships with the American Management Association and the Small Business Administration offer unique opportunities for students in the College of Business Administration.

The baccalaureate program in accounting has achieved significant recognition. CCSU students have always scored well above the state average in successfully passing the State CPA examination. On the 1978 examination, CCSU students had the second highest pass rate of all public Universities in Texas.

The College of Business Administration has already established for itself a solid reputation as a strong academic entity and its future is bright.

Phi Chi Psi, was originally formed in the Fall of 1979, but was then known as the advertising club. It then became the Progressive Business Club, and then eventually adopted the Greek letters: Phi Chi Psi.

In the Spring of 1979, a letter was sent to Mike Tillar informing the Central Office of Delta Sigma Pi that Phi Chi Psi Professional Business Fraternity of Corpus Christi State University had voted to petition to Delta Sigma Pi for a local charter.

Although many professional and social functions were held during the Spring of 1979 through the Spring of 1980, the requirements for a petition were still not met.

However, in the Fall of 1980, Phi Chi Psi continues to petition Delta Sigma Pi for a local charter, under the distinct leadership of: Bill Pengelly, President; Albert Welch, Senior Vice-President; Wayne Oakes, Vice-President for Professional Activities; Jenny Koetz, Chancellor; Elizabeth Moses, Secretary; Teri Aleman, Historian; and Lucy Blengio, Treasurer.

Activities during the Fall of 1980 include such distinguished speakers as, Jim Sutton, Vice-President of Rotan-Masle, Inc., and Cal Koontz, General Manager of Dillard's Department Store. Other activities also include the sell of raffle tickets to raise funds to help cover membership dues for Delta Sigma Pi, and a community service project that consists of "Trick-Or-Treating" for UNICEF.

Phi Chi Psi has 25 members who are dedicated to the goals of Delta Sigma Pi. As Corpus Christi State University continues to grow, so will our Fraternity.


