




Dear Fellow Board Members:

It is with great pleasure that I write this letter of recommendation for the Sigma Mu Beta Colony of the International Fraternity of Delta Sigma Pi, located at the State University of New York (SUNY) at Binghamton.

It was my privilege to assist in bringing together many fine students to act as the core group of Sigma Mu Beta. Having come from Epsilon Lambda Chapter at Rochester Institute of Technology I was very aware of what attributes and attitudes are important to a Chapter of Delta Sigma Pi. It is my feeling that the students enrolled in the School of Management at SUNY Binghamton possess the ability and desire to make a Chapter of Delta Sigma Pi a leading student organization, not only within the School of Management, but campus wide.

The elected officers of Sigma Mu Beta all took their positions with no knowledge of what was expected of them. 

## THE HISTORY OF SUNY-BINGHAMTON

The State University of New York dates back to 1946, when it began as Triple Cities College in Endicott. It was then a branch of Syracuse University.

In 1950, Triple Cities College became Harpur College and was incorporated in the SUNY system.

Because the school had an excellent reputation and a rapid enrollment, Harpur College was selected to become one of the four university centers in the SUNY system in January of 1965. Harpur College became the undergraduate liberal arts and sciences school and retained its identity within the university. Four professional schools were developed: the School of Management, the School of General Studies, the School of Advanced Technology, and the School of Nursing.

Today, SUNY-Binghamton has approximately ten thousand enrolled students. Spread over a six hundred six acre campus in the town of Vestal, one mile west of Binghamton, it provides for these students a broad range of educational services of a multi-purpose university. It offers the students a wide range of programs which lead to the Bachelor's, Master's, of Doctor of Philosophy degrees.

## THE HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT

SUNY-Binghamton's School of Management was created eleven years ago to unify the many areas of business and management. Prior to this time, the school was a department within the general liberal arts institution of Harpur College.

The School of Management is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. It is currently in the process of self-study for accreditation by the American Assembly of Collegiate Schools of Business.

As of September, 1980, five hundred twenty-five undergraduate students and three hundred forty-three graduate students were enrolled in the School of Management.

The school offers undergraduates a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration. There are two alternate fields--accounting and management. The accounting student must take one hundred twenty-six credit hours, including fifty-two liberal arts, sixty-four business, eight electives, and two credits of physical education. The management student must also complete one hundred twenty-six credit hours. These are to include fifty-eight liberal arts, forty-six business, twenty electives, and two physical education credits.

In the graduate area, the School of Management offers a Master's of Business Administration, a Master's of Science in Accounting, a Master's of Science in Management Science. An external degree program is held at Griffis Air Force Base in Rome, New York.

## HISTORY OF SIGMA MU BETA

Sigma Mu Beta was formed in March of 1980 by Deltasigs Joseph Krupka and Leon Niles. These two men had graduated from Rochester Institute of Technology where they belonged to the Epsilon Lambda chapter of Delta Sigma Pi. As graduate students at SUNY-Binghamton, Joe and Leon saw great potential for a local chapter.

After the groundwork was completed by consulting with university officials, Sigma Mu Beta came into being. Out of a pledge class of thirty-seven, nineteen were initiated as brothers on May 4, 1980.

Spring activities included car washes at a local gas station and a speaker from Bache Company. Also, Sigma Mu Beta was invited to join the Inter-Greek Council.

Mr. Dick Parnitzke, Eastern Regional Director of Delta Sigma Pi, first met with us in April to aid us in nationalization. His presence among us began to turn the dream of joining Delta Sigma Pi into a reality.

Upon returning to school in September, we set to work with determination. Our first mixer drew sixty pledges, showing an avid interest in our activities and goals.

Much of our efforts during the early fall were spent educating and initiating our new brothers. We did manage to participate in an Inter-Greek party, to sponsor a major movie on campus, and to run a series of donut sales in the University Union. Professor Hill, a local lawyer and SUNY-Binghamton business law professor, spoke to us about careers in business law. We were also privileged to hear speakers from Merrill Lynch, International Business Machines, and Singer-Link Corporation. We were invited to attend the Eastern Regional Conference in Rochester on November 1, 1980. Six of our brothers represented the fraternity at that educational experience.

At the present time, we are in the process of selling advertisements for a blotter to be distributed at the beginning of the spring semester. Also, in the immediate future we have scheduled various community service projects. \*\*

Working closely with Dick Parnitzke, we have completed the requirements for a charter to establish a local chapter. We feel ready to join the international organization and in need of that affiliation to better ourselves, our fraternity, and our community.

\*\*In early November, Sigma Mu Beta held two bake sales to support the United Way. A fifty dollar donation was made to that organization.

Sigma Mu Beta has various community service activities planned for the remaining weeks of the fall semester.

First, we are planning to renovate some rooms in the local Y.W.C.A.. We will be donating our time, manpower and most likely some supplies such as paint and wallpaper.

We are currently looking into the possibility of visiting nursing homes on weekends and we have found that there is a lack of male volunteers in the community for this service. We feel we can help the community in this way by donating our time, female and especially male, and visiting the homes.

Last, we are planning to collect Christmas gifts from local merchants to donate to various youth organizations for underprivileged children.

Sigma Mu Beta feels that it has the manpower and desire to create an excellent community service program, and with time it will.
