The South Central Province receives an allocation of \$10,614 based on our share of chapters and their distance as a % of all chapters in the country. The Provincial Leadership Team proposes to allot the \$10,614 for 2026-2027 as reflected above. Funds may be reallocated between line items at the discretion of the PVP.

Notes for 2026-2027:

- 1 - Regional budgets are based on each region's share of the weighted % of: the number of chapters (\$3657), and the total distance between all chapters in the region (\$3657), out of \$7314 total.
- 2 - RVP Budgets may include travel expenses related to chapter visits, startup group visits, initiations, and other events in the Region.
- 3 - PVP Budget may include travel expenses related to chapter visits, startup group visits, initiations, and other events in the Province.
- 4 - Speculative startup group at the University of Houston and potentially others, this line item can be used to visit startups.
- 5- Most of the work that was done by provincial committees is now completed through the new national Work Groups and no longer needs to be budgeted at the provincial level.
